Release Editor/NFAA Director Notes:

From what I saw and heard, I felt the Florida Vegas Shoot was a success. We are planning on holding another one the weekend before the 'real' Vegas shoot in 2019 and Newberry has offered to hold it for us.

Let officers know how if you liked or didn't like the changes to the State 3-D shoots. Did you like having both on the same weekend and did you like shooting for money instead of awards?

It was nice seeing a lot of Florida archers at the National Indoor. Florida took home 3 bowls, 4 third places and all of the 2nd flight awards for Young Adult Olympic Freestyle. We had a lot of Olympic Freestyle shooters there and that was great.

Hints for our state shoots. Know the scoring rings on the target and ask before you assume how to score. At our state shoots we give out two score cards per person and assign you to a target. You must have three people in a group and four is typical. You will have two people keeping score for all the archers in the group (in pen since pencil can be erased) and one person calling the arrows. The extra person will help the person calling the arrows. If you shoot the wrong target, you do not get to shoot it again. Arrows are not to be removed from the target or touched prior to scoring the arrows (even if it is a non-scoring arrow). Lastly, score keepers will keep a running total and compare it to the other score keeper after every target. It is never permissible to reshoot arrows that have already been shot. I am typing this because all of the above have been broken at recent shoots. PS. A non-scoring arrow is scored as an M not a zero since a zero can be modified.

If you or your club has anything to share please email me. Pictures are nice as well.

Bids for State shoots will be decided at the State Field on May 19. Think about getting your club to bid for a shoot.

Hope to see you at the northern portion of the State International that Dale and I are hosting in Tallahassee.

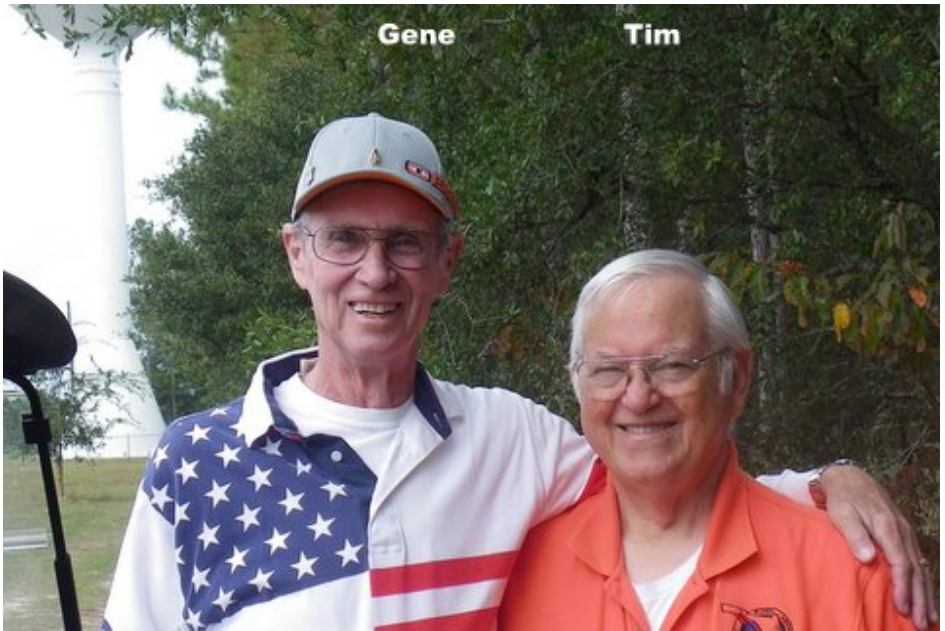
