

1. The FAA Board of Directors met at NAFAC at the Everglades Archery Range in Homestead at 4:55 PM on 7 December 2012. Present: Tim Austin (Sec/Treas), Bob Jones (President), John Laudicina (South), and Mike Marlow (Northwest), Shelly Mascaro (NAA Representative), and Ron Lucas (North) Absent:, Jake Pettitt (Central), Oliver Austin (NFAA Director), and Shannon North (Release Editor) and GUESTS: Various present at range.

2. Minutes of previous meeting were approved. CLOSED

3. The financial report was unanimously approved. So voted. CLOSED

4. NO REPEAT REGISTRATION IN SAME DIVISION IN SAME CHAMPIONSHIP: South moved and Northwest seconded that there be no second registration allowed in the same division at an FAA event. (Note: A second registration in a different division at the Indoor is allowed, but this motion will stop individuals from re-shooting a round in the same division.) SECOND READING: Approved. CLOSED

5. FAA PRO DIVISION MEMBERSHIP: NFAA Director moved and Northwest seconded. Where no requirement exists for Pro Membership in another organization for individuals who shoot Pro in a different organization, FAA will not require pro membership in FAA/NFAA competition. SECOND READING: South votes No. Everyone else votes to approve. CLOSED

6. START TIME AT FITA FIELD: South moved and Northwest seconded to have the Saturday start time at the FITA Field Championship 11:00 AM with check in by 10:30. So voted. OPEN FOR SECOND READING

7. TIE BREAK AT FITA FIELD 6's: Change the wording in our rule book from "X" ring to "6" due to the change in scoring by USA Archery. Approved. OPEN FOR SECOND READING

8. Mike Marlow suggested that we have a "Donation Jar" at State Championships for donations to the FAA Scholarship Fund. Unanimously approved. CLOSED

9. FAA SENIOR DIVISIONS TO 50+, 60+, AND 70+: FAA Secretary moved to change our "senior" divisions from 55+ and 65+ to 50+, 60+, and 70+. South seconded. The North Vice President discussed 5 year increments, but the cost of awards and the lack of support in most organizations led us to follow the USA Archery, ASA, and IBO archery pattern which agrees with the participating older archer numbers. At this year's NAFAC, we had 105 shooters that included 22 age 70+, 26 age 60-69, and 19 age 50-59. The motion has all styles represented in 50+ age group and styles FS, FSL, and BB in 60+ and 70+ age groups. So voted. OPEN FOR SECOND READING (to occur telephonically in time to utilize in 2013 events).




