Concerning the item that was mentioned with Pro members who renew thier Pro memberships, but weren't aware that their regular NFAA membership was due (or about to be due), the directors came to the concensus that when the NFAA sends out the Pro Membership cards, it would also be a good idea to slip an extra card in the envelope reminding the Pro that the Pro membership is separate from thier regular NFAA membership and they will need to make sure it is up to date.

This is due to some Pro members who signed up as Pro either at Vegas or before Vegas, but when they get to their State Indoor Championship they are being told they aren't current NFAA members (which is true), but they thought they were current after paying Pro Dues.
