Greetings from Oliver.

Want to thank Joe Loureiro for all that he did for the Florida Archery Association. He recently resigned as Executive Vice President and will be missed. Hopefully he will decide to come back.

NFAA is going to have a new format for the Sectional Outdoor. It is a 12 target half round (24 target full round) with 3 arrows per target. It has no walk-ups and no fans. For the Field they are dropping the 80W and the 45W. The 15 yarder will be shot on the bunny face (20cm). You can also think of the 12 target rounds as an International Round with the Bunny and 15 yarder added to it. There is a Field, Hunter and Animal round versions for the 12 target round. We are offering both the original 14, 14, 14 and the new 12, 12, 12 at the State Field as separate shoots which can be shot either day (or you can shoot the same one twice). Both count towards shooter of the year. Targets 1-14 are the 14 target rounds and targets 15-28 will be the 12 target rounds.

NFAA will offer a Sectional Target. Sections have a choice of a Classic 600 or a 900. The SE Section is going with the 900. We are going to split the 900 between Gold Coast and Gator, with the Sectional being offered at each site.

FAA has our scheduling meeting on Saturday at the State Field after shooting is over for the day. Our clubs host the shoots we run, and we appreciate their willingness to host them.

Health news. I had surgery on Monday, March 9. The surgeon removed 14 lymph nodes. She managed to get 7 of the 8 that showed cancerous on the PET scan. I will now receive radiation to take care of the 8th node. Monday, May 23, I will see my Cancer Radiologist and my new Oncologist (my previous one left for South Carolina). On Tuesday, I will see the surgeon for my first post-op appointment. We will see how things go.

Florida Archery Assoc. 720 Outdoor

This is the first outdoor event of the season. The format consists of the World Archery Qualification Outdoor Target Round. Archers will shoot a total of 72 arrows, divided into two rounds of 36 arrows each (6 arrows shot six times). The target faces are 122 cm for recurve and barebow archers, while compound shooters will use 80 cm, 5-ring targets. The shooting distances are 70 meters for recurve and 50 meters for both compound and barebow.

North FL. State 3D Tournament

The FAA Central Marked 3-D tournament is scheduled for Saturday April 19. The event will consist of two 15-target rounds, all taking place in one day. The registration fee is \$30, with \$15 returned to the competitors. The tournaments will feature a 50% payout based on the financial breakdown from the NFAA Rule Book for the Pro Division.

FAA STATE FIELD CHAMPIONSHIPS

The NFAA Field Round consists of 28 targets arranged along an outdoor walking course. Archers shoot four arrows at each target, for a total of 112 arrows for the round. Target distances vary by division and are set between 20 and 80 yards. Each target is shot from a single distance, and distances may be either marked or unmarked, depending on the archer's division.

A Record-Breaking Year for Archery Excellence

The 2026 Lancaster Archery Classic, held January 22–25, 2026 at the massive Spooky Nook Sports Complex in Lancaster, Pennsylvania, delivered one of the most exciting tournaments in its history. With over 3,000 archers registered from around the world, this year's Classic once again proved why it remains one of the premier indoor archery events in the United States.

NFAA Confirms Sectional Target Format – SE Section Chooses the 900



The NFAA & FAA have announced that this year's Sectional Target event, scheduled for October 2026, will allow each section to shoot either the Classic 600 or the 900 round. The Southeast Section has selected the 900, which embraces the longer, more demanding format favored by competitive shooters.

This year, the Sectional 900 will be offered alongside the State 900 event, giving archers a streamlined opportunity to shoot at the same host sites. To support accessibility across the region, the SE Section will split the 900 between Gold Coast Archery in Delray Beach and Gator in Gainesville. Archers may complete the full Sectional at either location, ensuring flexibility without compromising competitive standards.

The NFAA 900 Round is an outdoor target archery format where 90 arrows are shot over three distances (30 at each) for a perfect score of 900. It uses a 122cm, 10-ring target, with adults shooting at 60, 50, and 40 yards, 5 ends of 6 arrows per distance. It is a high-scoring, precise game, often used for State and National championships.

Information and registration links will be posted soon on both the FAA website and the NFAA Sectional page, giving shooters everything they need to prepare.

With two strong venues and a classic 900 on deck, the Southeast Section is gearing up for an exciting October event.

Florida Archers Look Ahead as Sunshine State Games Return in 2026

The Florida Sunshine State Games-Archery have been officially postponed until the summer of 2026, when the Florida Sports Foundation plans to relaunch the event as an Olympic-style sports festival for amateur athletes of all ages.

The event will take place June 6-7, with the Florida Archery Association event location to be Gator Bowmen, 10404 SW Williston Road, Gainesville, Florida 32608

The weekend will feature multiple disciplines, including target, field, and marked 3-D archery. Competition begins at 9:00 a.m. each day, with a 720 round or 28-target field round on Saturday, followed by a 900 round or 30-target marked 3-D round on Sunday.

Held alongside the NFAA Rushmore Rumble and S3DA Indoor Open, the event opened the doors to the public just days after the annual ATA Trade Show, letting fans test, touch, and even plan their wish lists of products before they hit retail shelves.

Thousands of archers attended, enjoying hands-on demos and exclusive interactions with top brands. NFAA Outdoor National Target Championships 2026



The NFAA Easton Yankton Archery Center will host the 11th annual NFAA Outdoor National Target Championships, August 22-23, 2026. The event will be a 2-day outdoor shoot featuring an NFAA Classic 600 Round on Day 1 and an NFAA 900 Round on Day 2.

Collegiate archers can purchase the Collegiate Add-On to their registration to compete in their regular NFAA division and the additional Collegiate division. Collegiate scholarships to be awarded based on participation. Review the Collegiate Competition tab for more details.

tournament Format:

Classic 600 Round

1. Archers will shoot 4 ends of 5 arrows at 3 distances, beginning with the closest distance.
2. Cub distances will be 10-20-30 yards, Youth distances will be 30-40-50 yards and Young Adult/Adult/Senior distances will be 40-50-60 yards.
3. 4 minutes will be permitted for each end.
4. The target will be the 92cm NFAA multicolor target face with gold-red-blue, etc. NEW for 2026: Either the full target (1 through 10 scoring areas) or the center spot (6 through 10 scoring areas) will be assigned based on the archer's division. (Read more under General Rules for Classic 600 Round.)

900 Target Round

1. Archers will shoot 5 ends of 6 arrows at 3 distances, beginning with the furthest distance.
2. Cub distances will be 30-20-10 yards, Youth distances will be 50-40-30 yards and Young Adult/Adult/Senior distances will be 60-50-40 yards.
3. 5 minutes will be permitted for each end.
4. The target for all archers will be the 122cm multicolor face with gold-red-blue, etc. (10 through 1) scoring areas
